- 1. The student must be a resident of East Kingston.
- 2. The student must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in an approved two, three or four year program. Eligibility will be limited to four academic years.
- 3. The student must file a Brown's Academy Trustees Scholarship application, complete with college transcript, postmarked or emailed no later than May 1st. The application should include information on the student's need for financial aid and include such items as size of family, other family members in schools and colleges, unusual medical expenses, parents' occupations, student's own savings, and student's plans for earning part of his/her post-secondary school expenses.
- 4. Financial need, academic performance, educational intentions, and student's character and integrity will be factors weighed by the Committee in making the final decision.
