THE BROWN'S ACADEMY TRUSTEES' SCHOLARSHIP

The Brown's Academy Trustees' Scholarship is given in memory of Mr. Rufus Brown.

The Brown's Academy Trustees' Scholarship will be awarded annually to an Exeter High School senior, or a first-year college student, who has been accepted into an approved program. The following criteria for selection will apply:

- 1. The student must be a resident of East Kingston.
- 2. The student must be enrolled into an approved one, two, three, or four-year program as a full-time student for the next academic year.
- 3. A Brown's Academy Scholarship application must be filed and postmarked or emailed by May 1st of each year. Representatives of the Brown's Academy Board of Trustees will select recipient.
- 4. Financial need, academic performance, educational intentions, and student's character and integrity will be factors weighed by the Trustees in making a final decision.
- 5. Payment of the scholarship will be left to the discretion of the Brown's Academy Board of Trustees.
- 6. Presentation will be made at Exeter High School Annual Awards Assembly by a representative of the Brown's Academy Board of Trustees or a designee.
- 7. The Mary S. Corbett Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to that senior student from East Kingston who best exemplifies those characteristics of scholarship, citizenship and community service.
