8:40 p.m. Mr. Douglas Mellon, representing E. Melvin Bowley, presented plans for a subdivision on StageCoach Road. One set of plans denoted plans for 12 two acre lots. The other set contained plans for a "Cluster" development of 11 one acre lots, with open space making up the balance. Under a cluster plan, each buyer would become members of a home owners association, similar to a condominium association, and would pay for maintenance of the open space.
